

## FERRUH TARMAN / RESUME

Ferruh TARMAN started his secondary education in Bursa Işıklar Military High School, then in his senior year he returned to Eskişehir and graduated from Eskişehir High School. In 1957 he registered Civil Engineering Department of Istanbul Technical University, and completed his studies with MSc. degree in Civil Engineering. In 1962.

Ferruh TARMAN worked together with the Contractor Sahap Demirag (MSCE), in the Construction of 27 km long-İpsala Levees, as well as Eskişehir Irrigation Supply Mains Construction since 1955 through 1964.

In 1966, during his military service as a reserve officer, Ferruh TARMAN was responsible for Supply Mains Construction and Restoration of Istanbul Kalender Officer's Club and Kalender Mansion. Following his military service, he also continued his profession in the construction and contracting business. After the Adapazarı-Akyazı earthquake; he did the construction of Boarding Buildings of Adapazarı Elementary School and Cark Industrial Estate Area, TEK Adapazarı Treatment –Reparation Workshop Facilities. During this period he also accomplished The Reinforcement and Renovation Project of Adapazarı Government House. This project was recorded as the first design and application with an attempt for Reinforcement and Retrofit Approach for damaged buildings. This Building survived the latter, highly destructive Earthquake of Adapazarı-Gölcük in 1999 with minor damages, and recorded as a building which managed to pass through the two big earthquakes of different characteristics.

Up until 1994, He had undertaken the constructions over a thousand residence units and completed various public contracts.

Since 1994, he has continued his career in their newly established company **Tarman Construction and Trading Limited Company**.

We lost Ferruh Tarman in 2014; but his experience, light and passion of work will be with us till the end of our professional lives.
